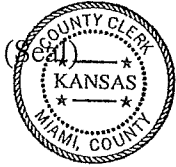
Shane Krull, Miami County Administrator, stated there are not any matters pertaining to the detention center project at this time.


Addition: J.R. McMahon, Director of Public Works Road & Bridge, requested the board


