THE MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI COUNTY, KANSAS

The Board of Miami County Commissioners met in regular session, in the Commissioners' Meeting Room, Miami County Administration Building, Paola, Kansas, on August 29, 2018. Those present were:

CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Dixon called the meeting to order at 1:00 p.m.

CONSENT AGENDA

Commissioner Roberts moved to approve the Consent Agenda, with three additions to New Business, as follows:

- Vouchers
- New Business Addition: Bid Award for E.M.S. Building
- New Business Addition: Contractor Bid for Administration Building Roof
- New Business Addition: Employee Appreciation Week Lunch

Commissioner Gallagher seconded; the vote was unanimous.

PROCLAMATIONS & PRESENTATIONS

Renee Slinkard, of the Daughters of American Republic, requested the board to consider the approval of a proclamation designating September 16-22, 2018 as Constitution Week. Commissioner Pretz moved to approve the proclamation and Commissioner Gallagher seconded; the vote was unanimous.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Shane Krull, Miami County Administrator, requested the board to consider the approval or rejection of a notice of bid (2018-010) award to Louisburg Ford and purchase a 2019 Ford Explorer. He stated the Appraisal/Reappraisal Department is interested in the Ford Explorer for \$26,106.68. Commissioner Pretz moved to approve the purchase and Commissioner Roberts seconded; the vote was unanimous.

NEW BUSINESS

Matthew Oehlert, Miami County Project Manager, requested the board consider authorizing an agreement (A18-08-012) with PbX Corporation for construction of Miami County Project No. 18-01-SB (648) Bridge Deck Patching & Polymer Overlays project in the amount of \$219,701.66. The project will be approximately 30-Day Working Project, starting construction on September 24, 2018. Commissioner Stiles moved to approve the agreement and Commissioner Gallagher seconded; the vote was unanimous.

Cathy Cooper, Director of Community Corrections, requested the board to consider approval for the Sixth Judicial Distrcit Community Corrections DOC-Adult Services FY2019 Carryover Reimbursement Budget Summary and Budget Narrative in the amount of \$109,069.77. She is requesting authorization by the Commission Chairman for signatory approval. Commissioner Stiles moved to approve the request and Commissioner Pretz seconded; the vote was unanimous.

Cathy Cooper, Director of Community Corrections, requested the board to consider approval for the Sixth Judicial District Corrections DOC – Juvenile FY2019 Carryover Reimbursement Budget Summary and Budget Narrative in the amount of \$39,861.44. She is requesting authorization by the Commission Chairman for signatory approval. Commissioner Stiles moved to approve the request and Commissioner Pretz seconded; the vote was unanimous.

Addition: Commissioner Roberts moved to approve the bid award to Legacy Contractors, LLC for the construction of the E.M.S. Building addition for a cost of \$845,000.00 with an additional \$38,000.00 for the roof on the existing building. Commissioner Gallagher seconded and the vote was unanimous.

Addition: Commissioner Pretz moved to approve the bid award to J.B. Turner and Sons for the replacement of the roof on the Administration Building, for a total cost of \$89,980.00. Commissioner Gallagher seconded and the vote was unanimous.

Addition: Commissioner Gallagher stated the Human Resources Department is requesting the Non-Emergency Offices be closed on September 14, 2018 from 11:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. for the Employee Appreciation Week Lunch. Commissioner Gallagher moved to approve the request. Commissioner Roberts seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

REPORTS FROM STAFF, COMMITTEES, OFFICERS

Matthew Oehlert, Miami County Project Manager, stated the bridge on Indianapolis Road has been closed for the 90-Day Working Project. The project should be completed no later than November 24, 2018.

PRESENTATIONS BY MEMERS OF THE COMMISSION

Commissioner Pretz wished a happy early birthday to the County Clerk Janet White.

Commissioner Roberts requested the Chairman set a date for the groundbreaking at the E.M.S. Building and informed the public that the project is fully funded with tax-dollars that have been set aside for this specific project.
