

RESOLUTION NO. R13-04-016

**A RESOLUTION LEVYING A COUNTY RETAILERS'
SALES TAX IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE-QUARTER OF
ONE PERCENT (.25%) WITHIN MIAMI COUNTY, KANSAS**

WHEREAS, at an election held on April 2, 2013, a majority of the electors of Miami County, Kansas (the "County") approved the levy of a retailers' sales tax in the County in the amount of one-quarter of one percent (.25%) with revenue from the tax to fund construction of a new jail facility and all things related thereto with such tax to expire when sales tax sufficient to pay the costs of financing the jail facilities has been collected by retailers as determined by the Kansas Secretary of Revenue.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI COUNTY, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. A retailers' sales tax in the amount of one-quarter of one percent (.25%) is hereby levied in the County according to K.S.A. 12-187 et seq., and particularly K.S.A. 12-187(b)(2). The retailers' sales tax shall take effect on October 1, 2013, or on the earliest date thereafter that the Kansas Department of Revenue can begin collecting such retailers' sales tax, and shall expire when sales tax sufficient to pay all the costs of financing the jail facilities has been collected by retailers as determined by the Kansas Secretary of Revenue.

SECTION 2. Except as may otherwise be provided by law, such tax shall be identical in its application and exemptions to the Kansas Retailers' Sales Tax Act and all laws and administrative rules and regulations of the Kansas Department of Revenue relating to the state retailers' sales tax shall apply to such County retailers' sales tax insofar as such laws and regulations may be made applicable. The services of the Department of Revenue shall be utilized to administer, enforce and collect such tax.

SECTION 3. This resolution shall take effect upon adoption by the Board of County Commissioners. A duly certified copy of this resolution shall be submitted to the Kansas Department of Revenue, along with a copy of the canvas of election conducted by the Miami County Board of County Commissioners and a copy of the County's resolution calling an election on the question of levying the sales tax.


