## A Small Change Can Make A Big Difference!



When you shift \$20 of your weekly spending to a local business it generates \$1.85 in sales tax. But did you know that sales tax revenue is split between the state, the county, and the city? The city keeps just 25¢ and uses it to pay for general operations. **Just 25¢. Small change really does impact our community.**

$$2,424 \text{ Households in School District} \times \$20 \text{ Weekly Shift} \times 52 \text{ Weeks} = \$2,520,90 = \$31,512 \text{ in local sales sales tax for Osawatومية District}$$

### 9.25% Sales Tax? Where does the money go?

- \$1.30 State** For education, social services, road & bridge
- 30¢ County** For road & bridge, new jail, & general operations
- 25¢ City** For general operations
