Economic Development

Population Estimates

On July 1 of each year, The Governor's Economic and Demographic Report releases population estimates for the state's previous year.

These population estimates are formulated by using the latest decennial census data as a benchmark and incorporating administrative data from federal agencies.

The estimates help identify population shifts and trends for the state, the region and the nation, as well as indicating changes to the population of specific groups of individuals.

The 2021 estimates show a continued increase in Miami County's numbers.

As a state, the population was estimated at 2,934,582 representing an overall increase in the past year of almost 21,000 people.
