Miami County and Waste Management have worked together to make drop off more efficient and easier for Miami County residents. This way you will not have to wait in long lines. This year's drop off will be done at your convenience and availability.

Miami County residents may dispose of refuse (excluding tires and appliances containing Freon) free of charge during this time period. Residents must provide proof of residency by either a valid identification or by property ownership.

Loads *MUST* be separated in the following categories

- **Brush:** Tree trimmings, stumps, etc.
- **Scrap Metal & Non-Freon Appliances:** Including but not limited to: Tin, mowers, appliances (washers, stoves, etc.) and any other all metal items.
- **All other trash:** Anything not included in the above categories: Household trash, micro-waves, furniture and any other waste.

Limitations/Fees:

- **4,000 lbs. max load per resident (One load per resident only) – first 4,000 lbs. are free. Once weight limit is reached normal pricing will commence.**
- **Tarp – all loads** must be tarped (per KSA #8-1906). If load is not tarped a **\$10** charge is added.
- **Freon appliances** (air conditioners, freezers, refrigerators, etc.) – **\$54.72 per appliance.**
- **Tires:**
 - a. 16.5 inches or less – **\$6.12 per tire**
 - b. 17 to 24.5 inches – **\$8.49 per tire**
 - c. 25 inches or higher – **\$13.42 per tire**
- **No Contractor or Commercial Loads**

*****PPE IS REQUIRED.** You must have a **Hard Hat and Safety Vest** to enter the Transfer Station, and if you don't have one they can be purchased from WM for the following fee: **Hard Hats \$8.00 each, Vests \$3.50 each. *****

WM reserves the right to make a final determination on all materials disposed of including but not limited to fee assessment, rejection of loads, etc.

(Household Hazardous Waste cannot be disposed at the transfer station. To dispose of these products, such as oil, non-latex paints, chemicals, cleaners, etc., please contact Miami County Household Hazardous Waste at 913-294-9578.
