A Small Change Can Make A Big Difference!



When you shift \$20 of your weekly spending to a local business it generates \$1.90 in sales tax. But did you know that sales tax revenue is split between the state, the county, and the city? The city keeps just 230¢ and uses it to pay for things like improvements to our streets and stormwater system, and operating and maintaining our aquatic center. **Just 30¢.**

Small change really does impact our community.

$$3,522 \text{ Households in School District} \times \$20 \text{ Weekly Shift} \times 52 \text{ Weeks} = \$3,662,880 = \$54,943 \text{ sales tax for Louisburg}$$
